Performance Guidelines

Thank you for volunteering your time to coordinate a performance for the International Festival! Your effort is greatly appreciated and contributes to an inclusive and diverse event

that our school is very proud of.

The overarching goal of International Fest performances is to bring our entire community together to celebrate diversity and educate one another about our different cultures. All performances will be held in front of the outdoor stage during the Saturday afternoon festival.

Process

Step 1: Submit Performance on the online form in one of the following categories:

A. **Dance:** Music with dance preferably group (max of 18-20 kids)

B. **Instrumental:** no dance, no vocal, just performance with instrument

C. **Vocals:** Singing with or without music, no dancing.

Step 2: Committee will select which performances will take place and what order based on the following criteria:

1. **Representation:** The performances with the most Live Oak Student representation will take priority.

2. **Diversity in Performance:** Looking to represent a variety of nations. Fusion of performances encouraged and will take priority.

3. **Variety:** If a country submits more than one performance, selection will be compared on dance styles and variety in category- dance, instrumental, vocals.

Step 3: Once performances selected, countries will be notified and performance schedule will be released.

General Rules For Performance Coordinator:

1. All performances are limited to a 3:00 minute time slot.
2. Ensure that the **majority**, if not all, of your performers are Live Oak students.
3. Provide the PTA Performance Coordinator/s with a brief but descriptive introduction to your performance (couple of sentences will suffice).
4. Let the PTA Performance Coordinators know if you have specific needs (microphones etc).
5. All performers must arrive and check-in at MPR, 15 minutes prior to performance time.
6. After checking-in they must remain in the MPR until their performance. It is very difficult for volunteers to come looking for performers.
7. If your performance involves music/song, a link will be provided to upload your music to a Google folder. This link will be shared with you via email.
8. Rehearsal dates and locations will be announced close to the event date. Email for scheduling rehearsal will be sent out soon.
9. Please note, there are no Friday Assembly performances. **ALL PERFORMANCES ARE SATURDAY APRIL 21,2018.**
